Start brushing on Woodbury Creek and Silver Spray Trails in Kokanee Glacier Park
- 2014 - Obtain grants to hire 1 student and another person (to act as Assistant Manager) for the Visitor Centre in support of the West Kootenay EcoSociety  
Work with the Nelson & District Arts Council to raise funds for the Visitor Centre through the sale of local art.  
Participated in the celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> Birthday of Pilot Bay Park at Pilot Bay Lighthouse.  
Designed and installed new information signs along the Kokanee Creek Spawning Channel (great work Ursula) – obtained grant from Nelson & District Credit Union for half of the cost.  
Awarded BC Parks "Volunteer Group of the Year" - attended award lunch at Kokanee Creek Park hosted by BC Parks staff.  
Continued with Trevor Campbell on the design of a topo map for Kokanee Glacier Park.  
Organized 2 work parties to brush Lemon Creek Trail in Kokanee Glacier Park

2015 - Obtain grants to hire 1 student and another person (to act as Assistant Manager) for the Visitor Centre in support of the West Kootenay EcoSociety. Purchased and installed signage directing tourists to the Pilot Bay Lighthouse. Designed and printed brochure/map about the Pilot Bay Lighthouse. Participated in organizational meetings and a hike on the lower Earl Grey Trail regarding a project to rehabilitate the trail for Canada 150 celebrations. The Friends will raise funds for interpretation signage at the compressor site and a sign celebrating First Nations use of the trail.
